## UPCOMING ENERGY CODE CHANGES FOR RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION

Florida Energy Conservation Building Code R101.4 States:

<u>Effective July 1<sup>st</sup> 2017</u>; New Construction on residential buildings or dwelling units shall have mandatory Blower Door Testing performed by an *Approved* Testing Agency. Duct Leakage testing already required if Prescriptive or Performance default not used.

## **Approved Testing Agency individuals** who can conduct the test means:

- Individuals defined under FS 553.993 (5) or (7)
  - Energy Auditor or Energy Rater
  - > Currently Certified through RESNET, BPI or other approved agency or organization
- Individuals licensed under FS 489.105(3) (f), (g) or (i); who have received proper training in blower door and duct leakage testing methods and procedures.
  - Class A Air Conditioning Contractor
  - > Class B Air Conditioning Contractor
  - Mechanical Contractor

Blower Door Testing and Duct Leakage reports performed by Approved Testing Agency shall be signed by a qualified individual and submitted to the Building Division prior to issuance of Certificate of Occupancy.

## To be an approved Testing Agency in the City of Melbourne, you must:

- Show proof of licensure and/or certification as shown above.
- Provide proof of liability insurance
- Proof of workman's compensation insurance or exemption
