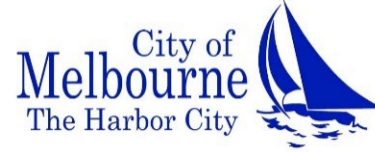

Miscellaneous Paper & Plastic

- Plastic bags of all kinds, plastic packaging, and films
- Wrapping paper – Often contains glitter and foil
 - Pet food bags
 - Paper towels, napkins, and coffee cups
 - Plastic silverware, cups and lids
- Shredded paper (check brevardfl.gov for drop-off locations)



RECYCLE, *clean & dry* PLASTIC BAGS
at grocery stores and thrift stores



These go in the RECYCLING CARTS!



Mixed Paper

Mail, catalogs,
mixed paper



Newspapers



Paper bags



Paper roll cores



Magazines



Paper boxes from cereal,
shoes, eggs, toothpaste, etc.



Cardboard boxes (flatten)

Curbside Service: If too large to fit in cart

Clean & Empty – When in doubt, leave it out

Plastic & Cans



Plastic yogurt, salsa, margarine
containers *with lids* (empty)



Metal beverage and
food cans (empty)



Clean aluminum
pans (clean and dry)

Glass



Any color bottle & jar
no lids; labels OK



Clean & Empty
non-hazardous
aerosol cans;
lids OK



Bottles, jugs, and
tubs *with lids*
(rinsed)

Place *clean and empty* recyclables loose in carts
DO NOT include loose plastic bags or bag recyclables

If you have **large items that won't fit in the cart**, please call either Waste Management or the ECO Division (numbers below) to schedule a bulk collection.

For a **special bulk yard waste collection**, using the clam truck, please call Waste Management or the City's ECO Division to schedule.

Fencing and Other Construction and Demolition Material

Waste Management does **not** provide curbside collection of wood fencing or other construction and demolition material such as **lumber, fencing, docks, plywood, pallets**, and associated construction material that would be used to **construct a building, house, fence, dock, garage, shed, etc.** Consider **donating** building supplies to **Habitat for Humanity of South Brevard ReStore** (4515 South Babcock Street, Palm Bay; 321-728-4009)

- Residents are offered the following options:
- Take the pressure-treated wood to the **Brevard County Disposal Facility** (2250 Adamson Rd, Cocoa, FL). Residents can dispose of the wood there themselves at no charge.
 - Initiate Waste Management Bagster service. Bagsters can be purchased at local home improvement retailers and hold up to 3,300 pounds of debris and waste. For more information, visit [The Bagster](#) or call Waste Management (321-723-4455).
 - Establish service with a roll-off service provider.
 - Waste Management can schedule curbside collection, upon request, for an additional charge.

Household Hazardous Waste goes to Sarno Landfill

They accept **household chemicals** including aerosol cans, cleaners, fertilizers, fungicides, herbicides, pesticides, automotive batteries, fluorescent bulbs, paint (latex or oil), paint remover, paint thinner, pool chemicals, solvents, thermometers, thermostats, and wood preservatives.

*Propane tanks can be taken to AmeriGas Propane in Rockledge



Electronics are also accepted including flat screen TVs and monitors, VCRs, cell phones, computers, copiers, printers, fax machines, scanners, digital cameras, stereo equipment and telephones.

Residents can also purchase additional carts from Waste Management for \$70 each or can request a swap for a larger or smaller size garbage cart (35 gallon, 64 gallon or 96 gallon) for \$25 by calling (321) 723-4455.
